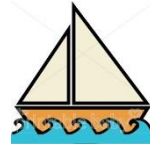

Recycling of mobile phones, tablets etc. help Traidcraft Exchange. Please see box in large hall on top of Traidcraft cupboard.

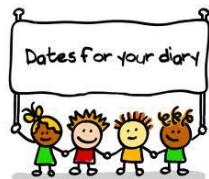
